## JUDGMENT

## KURIAN, J.

- 1. Delay condoned.
- 2. Leave granted.
- 3. The parties approached this Court with certain grievance regarding partition of their property. On being referred to mediation to resolve the dispute amicably, the parties have arrived at a settlement before Ms. Sudha Gupta, learned mediator, appointed by the Supreme Court Mediation Centre, and they have duly signed a Deed of Settlement dated 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2016. The said Deed of Settlement is taken on record.
- 4. Accordingly, the appeal stands disposed of in terms of the settlement, referred to above. The same shall form part of the decree.
