- 1. Leave granted.
- 2. In view of the order dated 23<sup>rd</sup> March, 2015, passed by the Presiding Officer of Industrial Tribunal No.2 at Vadodara in Reference (I.T.)No.12 of 2005 in pursuance of order passed by this Court on 1<sup>st</sup> December, 2014, this appeal does not survive.

In view of the above development in the matter, the impugned order dated 18<sup>th</sup> February, 2014 passed in Letters Patent Appeal No.1720 of 2005, affirming the order dated 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2005 passed by the learned Single Judge in Special Civil Application No.15652 of 2005 is set aside.
- 4. Needless to say that it would be open to the respondent to challenge the validity of the order passed by

the Tribunal.
