

(ThisnoteisnotpartoftheOrder)

ThisOrder,madepursuanttosection 13(1) of the Registered Designs Act 1949 with a view to the fulfilment of obligation sunder the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property ("the Paris Convention") (as revised at Stockholmin 1967 (Cm. 4431) and under the Agreement establishing the World Trade Organisation (including the Agreement on Trade Related as pects of Intellectual Property Rights) (Cm. 2556 -59,2561-69, 2571-74), declares Cambodia, Fiji, Grenada, Equatorial Guinea, Lao Peop les Democratic Republic, Oman, Panama, Papua New Guinea, Qatar, Sao Tomeand Principe, Solomon Islands and United Arab Emirates to be convention countries for the purposes of all of the provisions of the Registered Designs Act 1949.
